Possibilities in Pastel - List of Supplies

The Attached list is for sketching and painting in Charcoal and Soft Pastels. Pastel paper is available in sheets or tablets. My favorite is Canson MiTeintes Pastel Paper or Strathmore Pastel Paper. Either can be ordered on line from any art supply dealer or are available at Blick's in Tampa or Hobby Lobby in Clearwater.

1. Drawing Board - Smooth Surface to Sketch on
2. Box of Soft Pastels - At least 16 or 24 colors
3. Pastel Pencils – Black, Brown, White
Faber Castel, Stabillo “CarbOthello” or Cont’e
Plus any other colors you may prefer.
4. Pastel Paper Pad size 9” x 12” or 3 sheets of Canson
Mi Teintes size 19” x 25” (cut in quarters)
5. Kneaded Eraser - To clean up charcoal or pastels
6. Paper Stumps - At least 3 different sizes
7. Masking Tape - Thin
8. Wet Naps - Small package

**** Some of these could be cost prohibitive and not necessary the first week or two of class. I will be bringing all these materials to start each student out for first few classes, to see if you want to hold off and wait to see if it suits you before you invest in them.*
